This book presents a unique and multi-faceted history of a South African NGO prominent in youth development from 1985–2008. Drawing on two decades of interviews and ethnographic fieldwork, the book contextualizes the Joint Enrichment Project (JEP) in the politics and history of South African education, traces its work and influence, and explores the continued relevance of its legacy to contemporary initiatives seeking to address youth development and connect young people with employment. In examining the JEP's role leading up to and during South Africa's transition to democracy, it also sheds light on broader processes of socio-economic reproduction and change in post-apartheid South Africa.

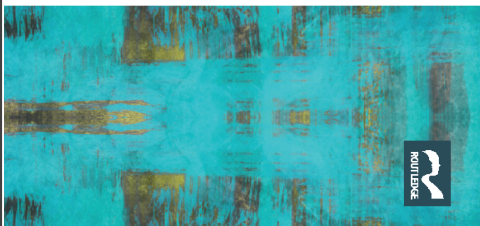
